At the conclusion of the event, participants stood together, hand in hand, and solemnly pledged:

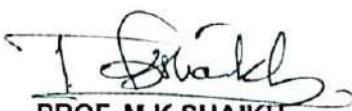

Activities:

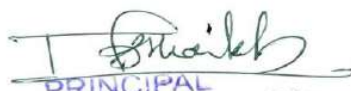
1. **Seed Collection:** Participants collected seeds from indigenous plant species.

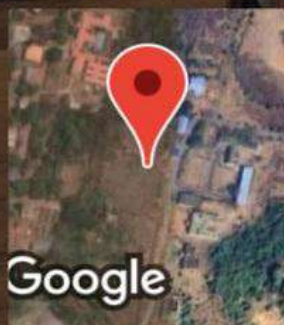

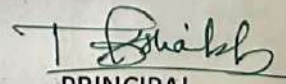

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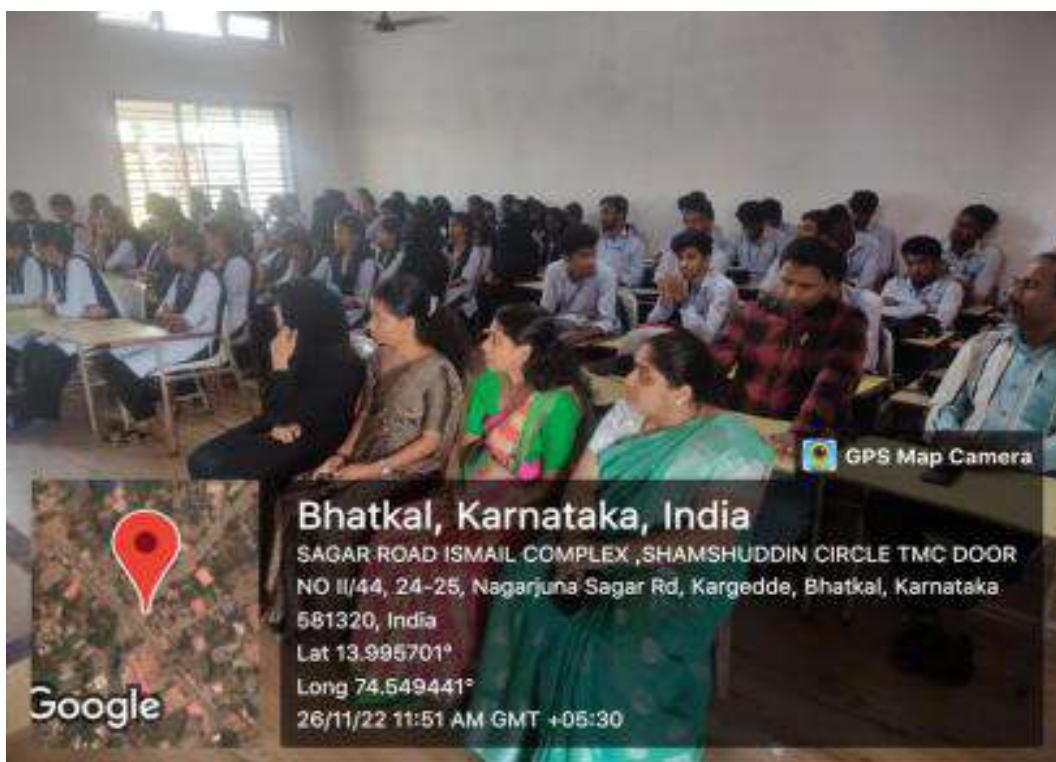
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14. CONSTITUTION DAY 2022-23

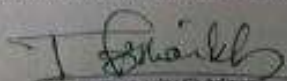
The seminar concluded with Prof. Malathi presenting a memento to Dr. Nuthan KP as a token of appreciation for her valuable insights and contributions to the event.

- **Community Involvement:** The people of Konar village participated enthusiastically, reinforcing the spirit of community service.



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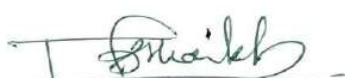

Acknowledgments: We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all the cadets, helping us organize and dedicate their time and effort to make this event a success.



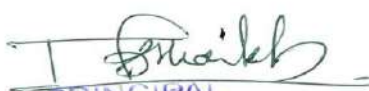

Economic Slowdown in India : Causes & Policy Initiatives

India has seen six successive quarters of declining GDP growth equalling the longest slowdown in the past 23 years. The last time India had witnessed six straight quarters of slowdown was between March quarter of FY11 and June quarter of FY13.

The current slowdown started in the first half of the last fiscal when India posted GDP growth of 7.95% in Q1 and 7% in Q2, respectively. Ever since, India has posted successive decline in GDP growth: 6.58% (Q3FY19), 5.83% in (Q4FY19), 5% (Q1FY20) and 4.5% (Q2FY20).

India has already lost the tag of the world's fastest-growing economy to China. India posted a growth of 5.8% in Q4 FY19, while China grew at over 6.4%. In Q1 FY20, India grew at 5.01% while China grew at 6.2%. In Q2 FY20, China posted a growth rate of 6%, and India is expected to settle at 4.7%.

The proposed Seminar aims to discuss the causes of the slowdown, and its short run and long run impacts on various sectors of the economy and policy initiatives to be adopted to overcome the present situation.

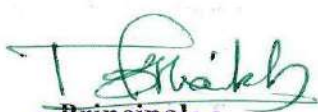

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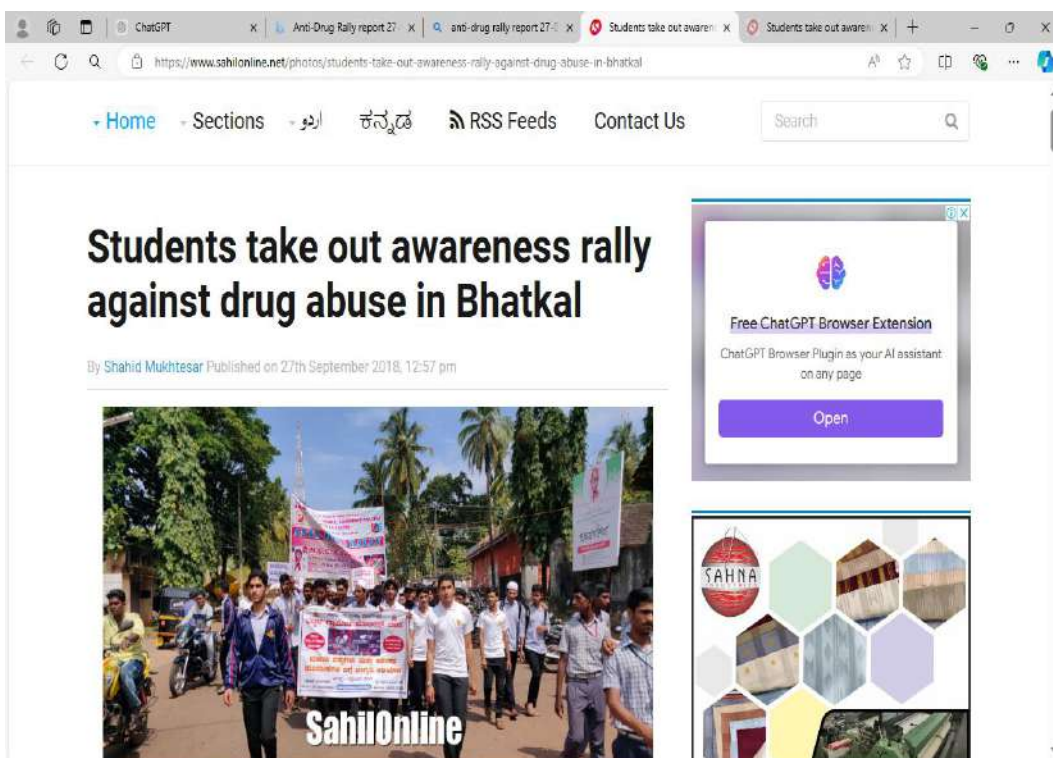
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Report on Anti-Drug Rally

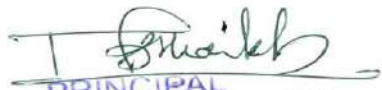

3. **Community Bonding:** The event fostered a sense of community and environmental responsibility among the participants.

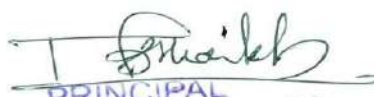
Conclusion
