Aim of the Policy:

Anjuman Arts, Science and Commerce College, Bhatkal awards several Scholarships and fee concessions to the college students every year. Our Institution is dedicated to empower students from every level of society by providing necessary support through various schemes and initiatives. These scholarships have been instituted by the Director Higher Education, various NonGovernment Organizations and by donations from college faculty. The scholarships are awarded with strict adherence to the conditions laid down by the funding organizations. The selection process entails applications from deserving students, who may be given partial or full tuition fee concession depending upon the category they have applied.

Objectives:

The scholarships and concessions policy adopted by the college is based on the following principles:

- To achieve the Government's motto "Education for All".
- To encourage the meritorious students from financially challenged families in pursuing their higher education.
- To provide financial assistance to the deserving students.
- To award the meritorious students of the college for their achievements.
- To involve faculty members to contribute towards the society.

Scope:

The scholarships and concessions are awarded to the students of each stream (UG and PG), especially students from Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), Schedule Caste (SC), Schedule Tribe (ST), Other Backward Class (OBC) and Persons with Disability (PWD). Scholarships can be in the form of freeships, concessions, awards, financial assistants or in the form of books and stationery.

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Policy statement:

The college offers variety of financial schemes and voluntary help to needy and deserving students. The college has evolved a scholarship policy for the students detailing the rules and guidelines to be followed. The policy takes into account giving a scholarship and/or tuition fee concession (half or full) to a deserving student in each discipline every academic year. However, depending upon the type and availability of sponsored funds, additional support is also taken into account. The scholarship shall be directly transferred to the account of the beneficiary student. In case the scholarship amount is credited in college account, it shall be immediately transferred to the student's account through cheque.

Institutional Scholarship and Fee Concession Schemes

- The college provides fee assistance to the deserving students at the time of the admission. The faculty members contribute voluntarily.
- The college provides fee concessions to the needy students from the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and other socially backward sections. The fee concession notice is issued and displayed on college website and notice boards. Students are required to submit the fee concession form along with supporting documents. The eligible students are shortlisted.
- The college also gives many cash prizes in the Annual Prize Giving Function to the meritorious students who have excelled in academics, sports and extra-curricular activities.
- Many faculty members help the needy students voluntarily by paying their college fees, providing books and stationery items to them or in any other kind as required.

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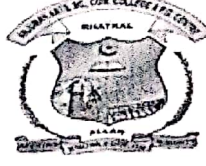



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Policy and Guidelines for the Scholarships/Financial Support to Students

1. The College shall provide the necessary information about the scholarships at the beginning of academic year.
2. The College shall notify the list of Government/Non-government Scholarships. All the notifications/circulars/brochures/other publicity materials received by the College will be prominently displayed.
4. The College is registered on all the Scholarship Portals of the Government and is also registered with all the departments which sanction scholarships to the students.
5. The College ensures that the Name of the College along with Institutional id/code is there in the portal for the easy and successful submission of the application by the students.
6. The duties of verification, e-verification, attestation, e-attestation are done as per the procedure.
7. The College office shall process all the application on time.
8. The Section shall guide, assist the students and establish liaison with the Governmental Departments and other agencies as required under the procedure.
9. The information is also displayed on the Students Noticeboards and Noticeboards meant for Scholarship Information
11. The information on scholarships/endowments/Scholarship Portals/NG)Scholarships/Charitable OrganizationScholarshipsInstitutionalEndowments are also provided.
12. It shall be the duty of the students to register and apply for the available scholarships as per the eligibility criteria.
13. Institutional Endowments shall be disbursed to the eligible students by the College based on the Endowment guidelines. Here the merit is considered.



14. There should be good academic track record to avail academic endowment scholarships/prizes
15. Students should not have any backlog in any subjects.
16. The Institutional financial support is considered depending upon the availability of the sponsored funds.
17. Eligibility to avail the scholarships shall be merit-cum-means.
18. Scholarships are for the needy students and shall reach the right beneficiary.
19. The College may provide inherent fee concessions for some courses as its Institutional Social Responsibility to promote the study of such courses that have very less takers in spite of their need for the society.
20. The College also provide support in the form of mid-day meals to needy students through its mid-day meals fund.
21. The College may also provide additional financial support/fee concessions to student achievers based upon the decision of the top Management/Trust
22. The College is committed to keep the students informed about the scholarships and provide necessary assistance. The students can use the internet facility in the Library to apply for the scholarships.
23. Any request for attestation, bonafide certificate, fee statement, study certificate shall be addressed immediately.
24. Renewal application alerts shall also be put on the notice board.
25. For any information and assistance on scholarship the students can contact the scholarship section in the administrative office.
26. For online scholarships the students are required apply online only. Students are provided with all the necessary guidance and they have to apply on their

Procedures:

At the time of admission itself the students are given information about various scholarships, the Scholarship Information Systems and Portals of the State Government and Central Government. Students are told to have their bank account and get the aadhaar seeded to it. Submission of the all the particulars such as Income Certificate, Caste Certificates, and other applicable documents are mandatory. Information about DBTF (Direct Benefit Transfer) is given as almost all of the Government Scholarships are disbursed directly to the bank account of the beneficiary.



The students/parents/guardians are advised to visit the National Scholarship Portal and State Scholarship Portal and complete the registrations. They are advised to keep the following details/documents ready while registering -
