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Considerations in Selecting a Research Design

Research Question

The research question guides the choice of design. For instance, if the goal is to examine cause-and-effect, an experimental design is appropriate.

Resources

The availability of resources, such as time, funding, and participants, can influence the feasibility of different designs.

Ethical Considerations

Ethical principles must be considered, such as informed consent, confidentiality, and minimizing harm to participants.



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Research Idea → **Research Design** → **Collecting Data** → **Analyzing Data** → **Publication Process**

Key Research Design Approaches

- ① **Experimental**
This design involves manipulating variables to observe their effects on outcomes. Researchers control for extraneous factors to establish cause-and-effect relationships.
- ② **Correlational**
This approach examines the relationships between variables without manipulating them. Researchers measure and analyze the degree of association between variables.
- ③ **Qualitative**
This design focuses on understanding complex phenomena through in-depth exploration of experiences, perspectives, and meanings. Data collection methods include interviews, focus groups, and observations.
- ④ **Case Study**
This design investigates a specific phenomenon or individual in depth. Researchers collect detailed information about the case to gain insights and understanding.

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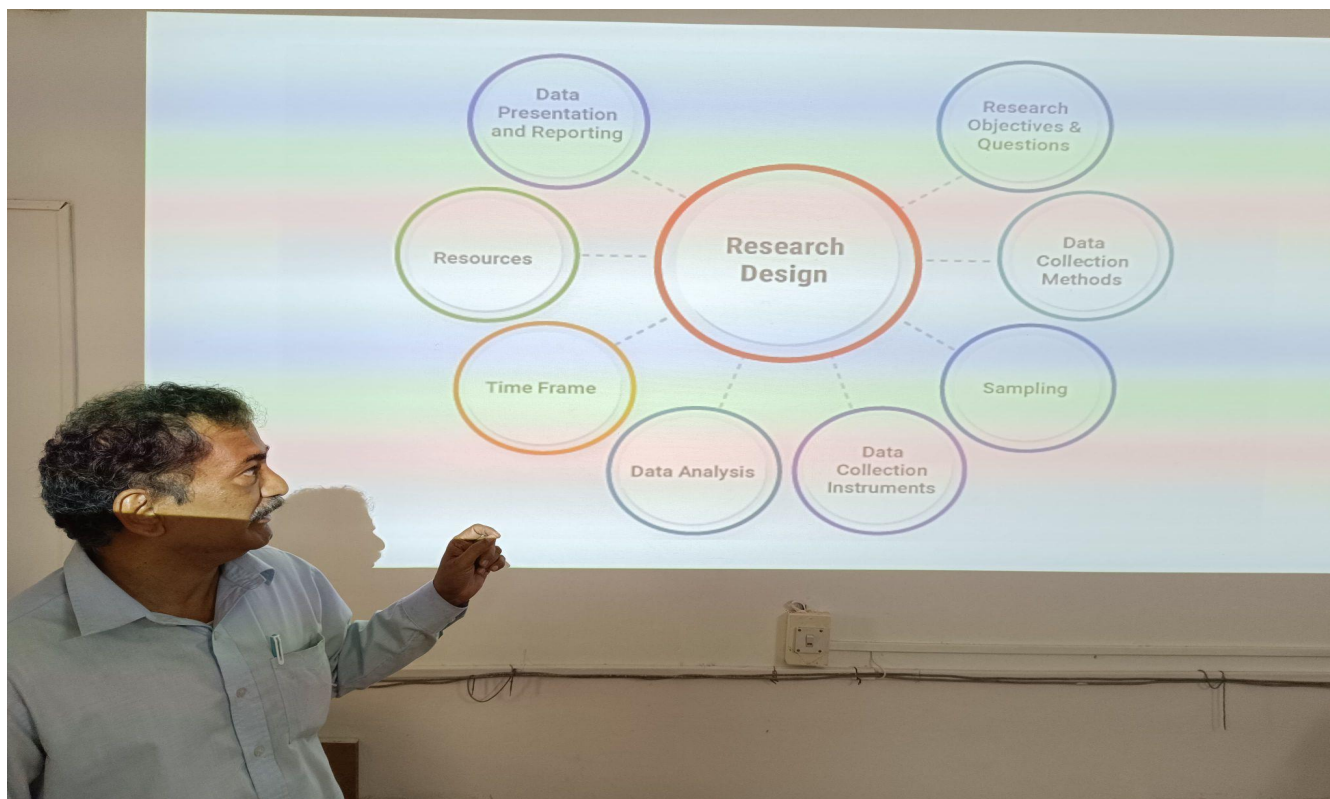
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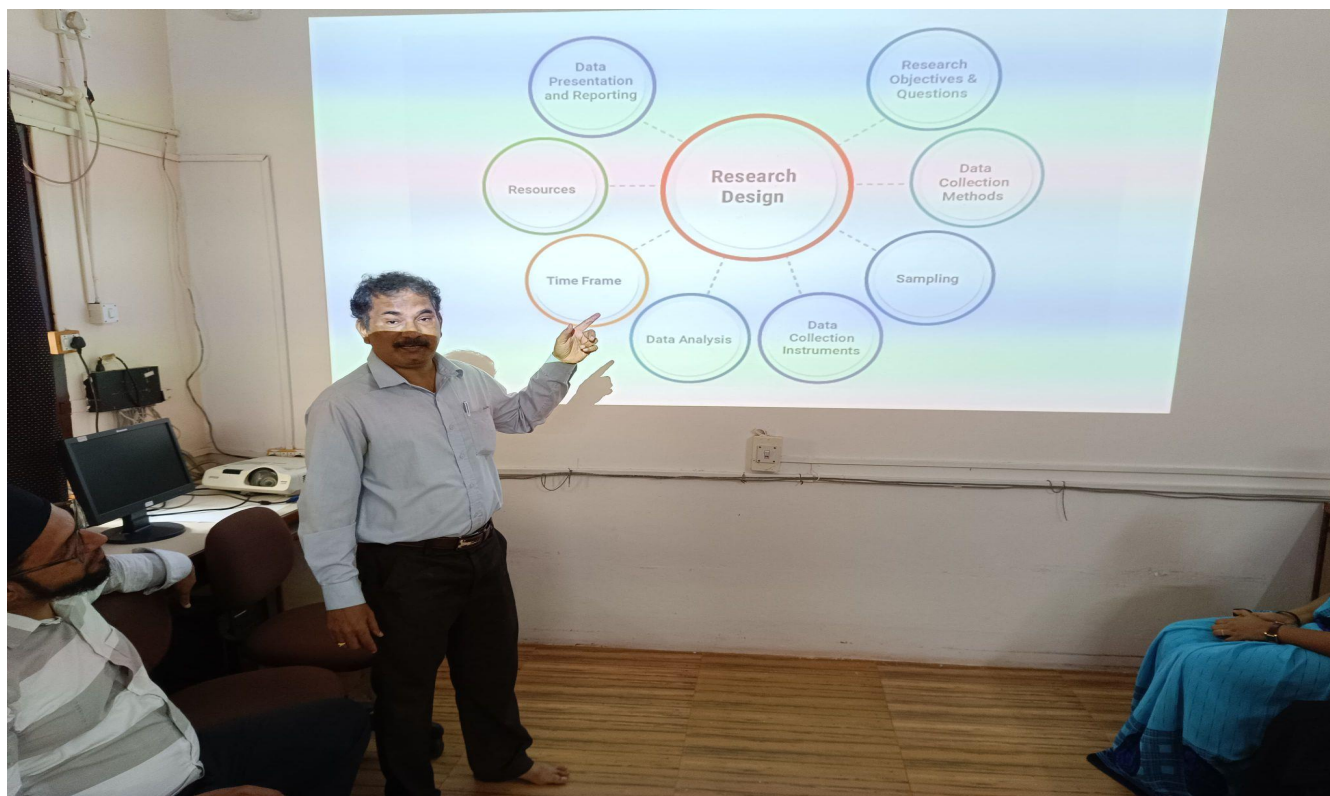
