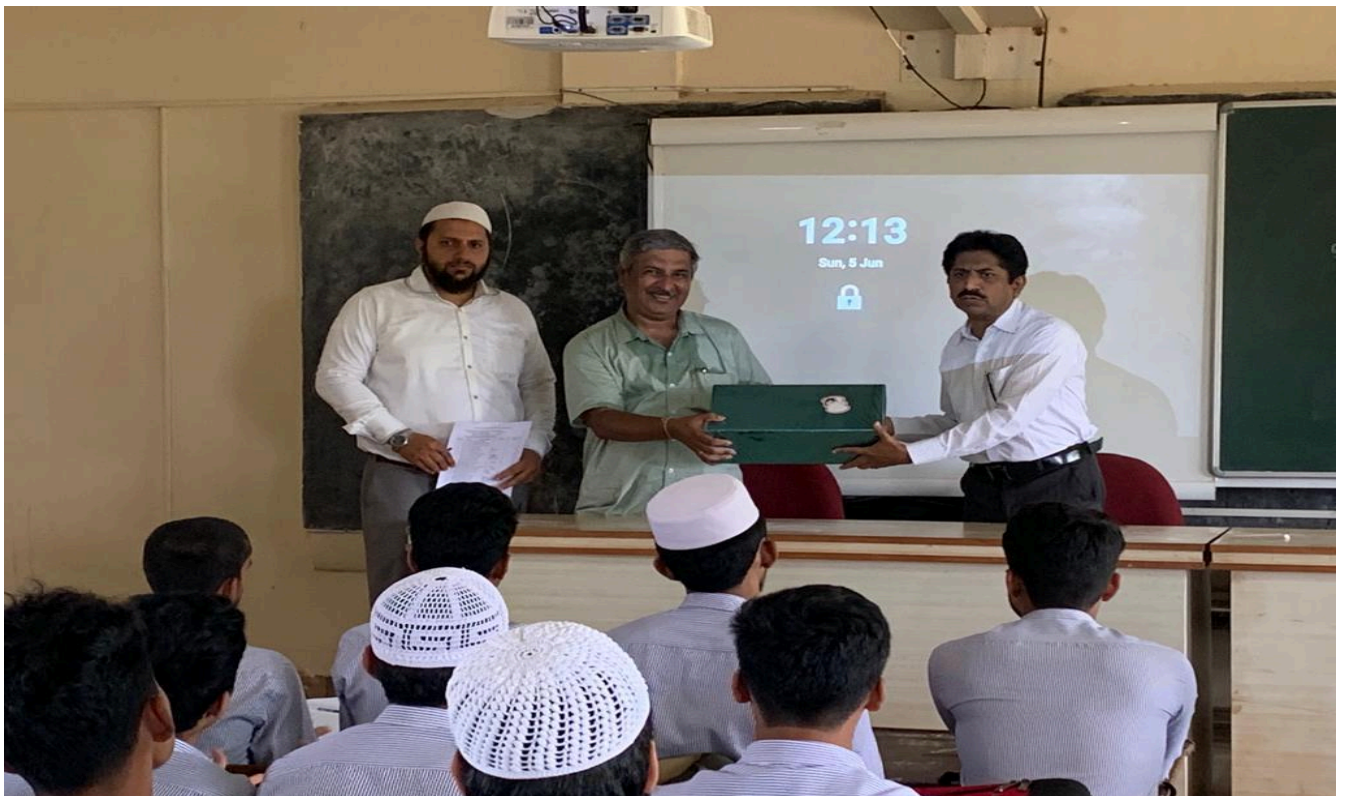

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Report on Guest Session on Entrepreneurship Development

The event took place on 5th of June. The key resource person was Shivanand V. Yaligar, Deputy Director of Centre for Entrepreneurship Development of Karnataka (CEDOK). The event was keenly organised by the Student Welfare Officer, Mr. Mohammed Ganim. The event started at 10:30 a.m. It was hosted by Ismail Ekkeri. To start off the event, Ainul recited some verses from the Quran. The respected Principal of our college gave the welcome speech. Maan gave the introductory speech and introduced our highly esteemed speaker for the day.

The guest speaker was a highly experienced one with more than 27 years of experience in teaching and training at CEDOK. With more than 500 training sessions conducted by him in a variety of topics, the students were bound to be benefited by his presence.

The guest speaker took over after the welcome speech and it was a start of a wonderful interactive session. He talked about the history of entrepreneurship right from the start of the 17th century and movement where it first started in India in Gujarat. He also talked about David McClelland's Kakinada Experiment and how he chose the fishermen for his theory for their risk-taking ability. He shed light on some of the initial institutes that were started in India for Entrepreneurship Development like NISIET (renamed to NIMSME), NIESBUD, etc. He then talked about the history of Entrepreneurship Development in Karnataka and explained to the students about TECSOK and their movement, the trainers recruited there and how the CEDOK came into existence. He also enlightened the students about two of the scientific research labs in Karnataka, i.e., CFTRI and NAL under CSIR.

He then elaborated about the various organisations promoting EDPs under the State and Central Government, the various bodies assisting in industrial developments like KIADB, KSSIDC and various other institutes under the government for raw materials, indigenous developments, finance, incentives, loan schemes (and subsidy), standardisation, etc. He also talked about the EDPs handled by CEDOK and also shed light on the Training Workshop held by them where our SWO, Mr. Mohammed Ganim had also participated. He also discussed about the Desire for achieving success in individuals and also the Achievement Cycle. He then introduced the students to the various steps in setting up an enterprise.

The guest speaker completed his address by 12:15 p.m. and Abdul Nafay delivered the Vote of Thanks. Later, students also took photos with the Guest to conclude the session on a happy note.
