REPORT ON SURGICAL STRIKE DAY COMMEMORATION

Subject: Report on NCC Cadets' Commemoration of Surgical Strike Day on 29th September 2018

- **Enhanced Planning:** Increase planning efforts for future commemorative events to ensure smoother execution and optimal impact.



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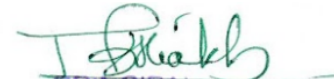
- Broader Engagement: Consider involving a larger segment of the college community and local residents to amplify the impact of similar events.
