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## REPORT ON SWACHHATA PAKHWADA PRACTISED BY NCC CADETS

**Subject:** Report on Swachhata Pakhwada Activity Organised by NCC Cadets on 10th December 2020

- **Extended Outreach:** Increase community engagement efforts and collaboration with local organisations to amplify the impact of cleanliness campaigns.



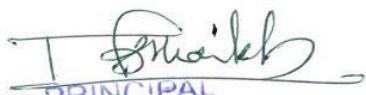
