REPORT ON STUDY VISIT TO GANESH SOAP FACTORY, SHIRALI

Date: September 05, 2021

Introduction

On September 05, 2021, a group of **33 students** from our institution, accompanied by Prof. B. H. Nadaf and Prof. R. S. Nayak, visited the **Ganesh Soap Factory** in Shirali. The purpose of this study visit was to gain practical insights into the soap manufacturing process and understand the operations of a soap production unit.

Factory Overview
