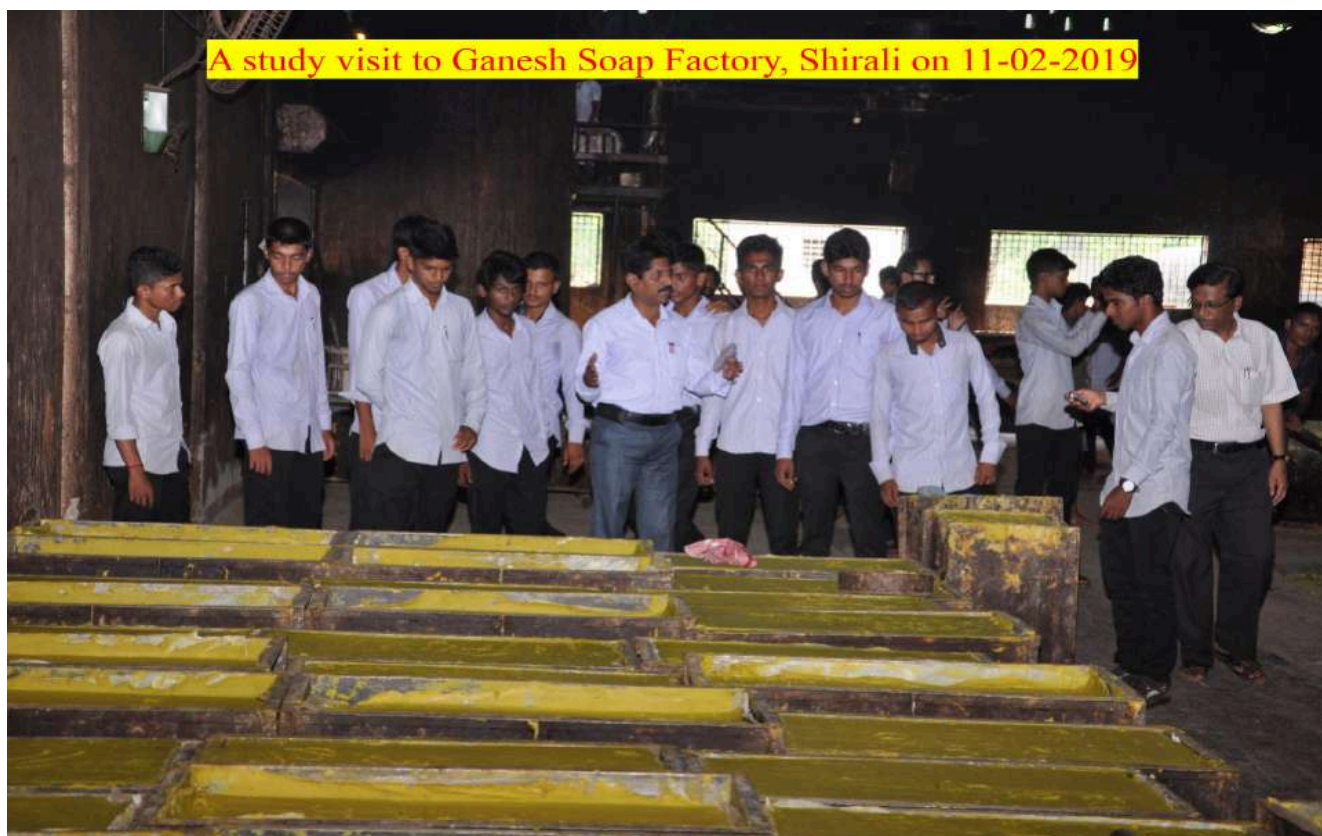

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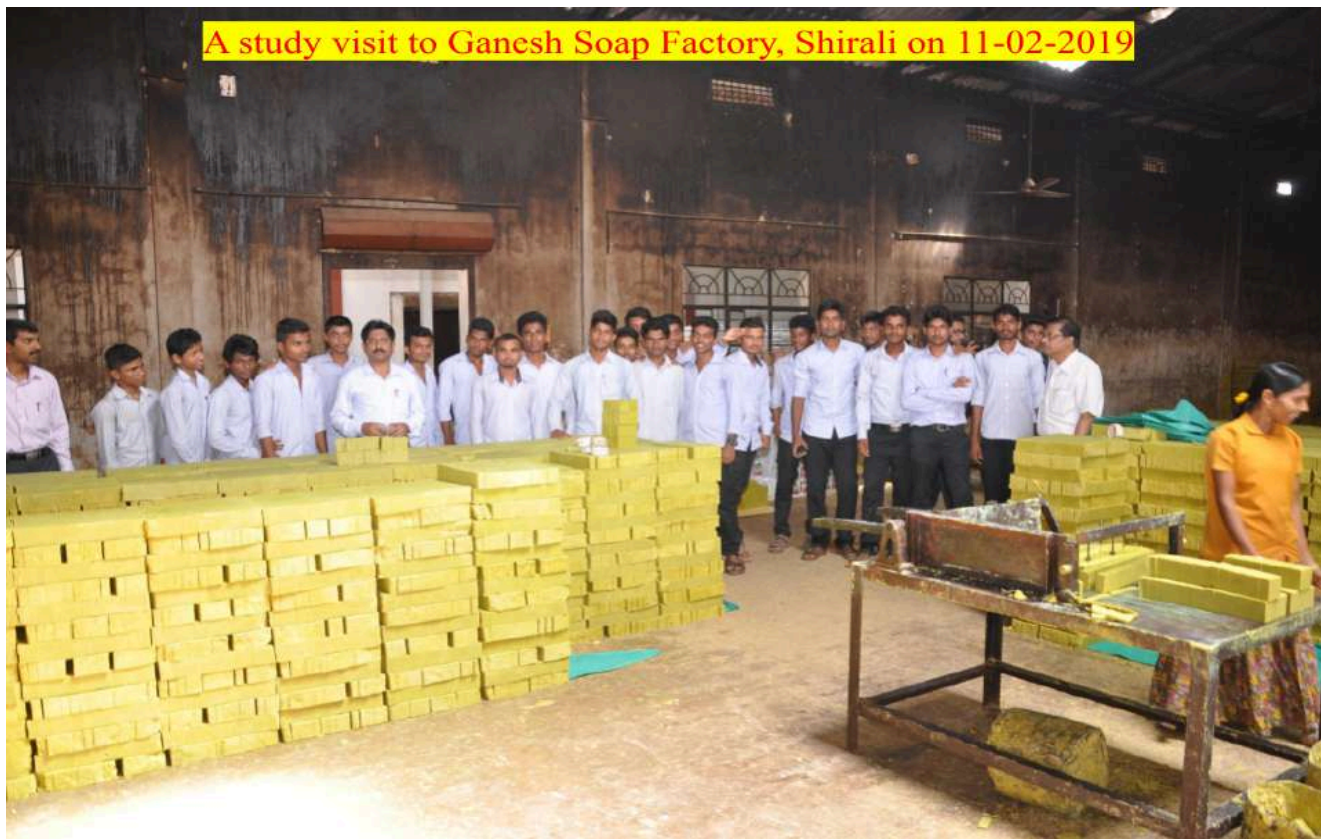

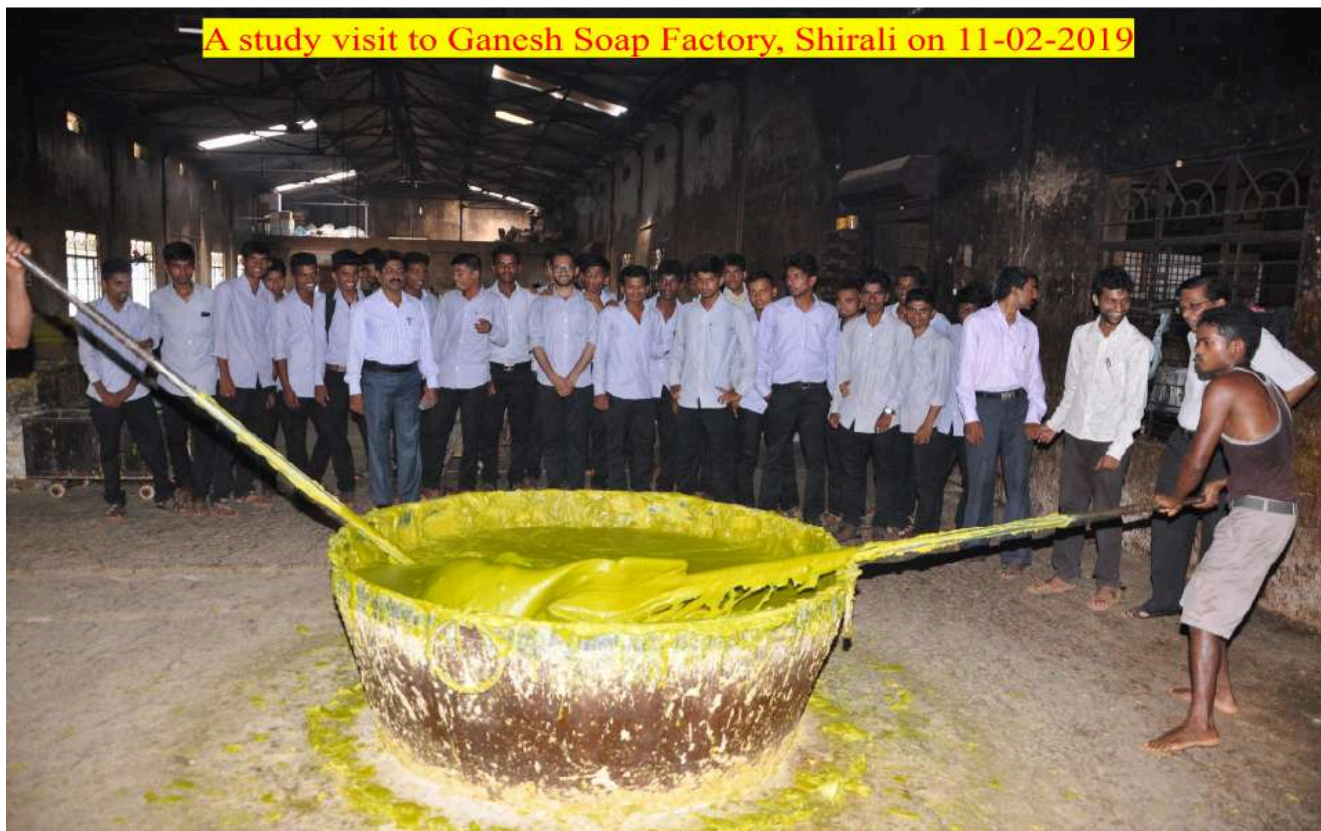

REPORT ON STUDY VISIT TO GANESH SOAP FACTORY, SHIRALI

Date: February 11, 2019

Introduction

On February 11, 2019, a group of **28 students** from our institution, accompanied by Principal Prof. M. K. Shaikh, visited the **Ganesh Soap Factory** in Shirali. The purpose of this study visit was to gain practical insights into the soap manufacturing process and understand the operations of a soap production unit.

Factory Overview

The Ganesh Soap Factory is a well-established soap manufacturing facility located in Shirali, Karnataka. It produces laundry soaps. The factory is equipped with machinery and adheres to quality standards.

Itinerary

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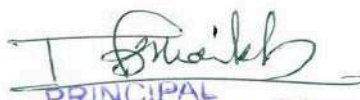
