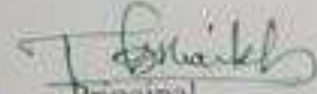

Anti-Ragging Cell

This Cell is functional with the Principal as the head, NAAC/IQAC Coordinator, one faculty member as Coordinator and three faculties as members. Anti-Ragging Cell should be one of the important parts of Educational Institution's mechanism. As per the guidelines of UGC under the Act of 1956, which is modified as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in higher Educational Institutions, 2009, establishment of Anti-Ragging Cell is very compulsory.

The UGC has issued very strong and detailed regulations for curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. As per regulations any of the following acts come under the purview of ragging.

- a.** Any conduct by any student or student whether by words (spoken or written) or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b.** Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c.** Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of such fresher or any other student
- d.** Any act by a senior student that prevents, disturb the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e.** Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic task assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f.** Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it; sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, Stripping, forcing for obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- g.** Any act or abusive spoken words, e-mails, public insults which would also included deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- h.** Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.

Punishment to those found guilty

The college level punishment in cases of ragging as per UGC directives includes one or more of the following:

1. Suspensions from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Debarring from appearing any test/ examination or other evaluation process
3. Withholding of results.
4. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
5. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for specific periods.

Objectives of Anti Ragging Cell

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels , Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. Anti- Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

The main objectives of this cell are as follows:

1. To prevent any physical or mental torture or any disorderly conduct towards any student causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation in him or her.
2. To maintain a ragging free campus.
3. To create awareness about ragging & ensure a student-friendly environment at all times.
4. To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished

Depending on the nature and severity of the guilt established by the Anti Ragging cell, A student indulging in ragging can be

1. Expelled from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. With holding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
3. Denied from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
4. With holding results.
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

- The students were asked to sign an affidavit at the time of admission that they will not indulge in any type of ragging in the campus. The parent's signature was also obtained in the affidavit that their ward will not indulge in ragging. A total of 691 affidavit was signed and maintained in the office.

Anti ragging cell coordinator and members are always vigilant in the campus and along with the anti ragging squad monitor the students and ensure that the college is a ragging free campus. Anjuman Arts, Science and Commerce College, Bhatkal, campus is ragging free, still all these measures have been taken to ensure that the fresher's are able to pursue their studies without getting troubled by the seniors. As the earlier academic year, in 2022-2023 academic year also, Anjuman Arts, Science and Commerce College, Bhatkal, did not face any ragging situation inside and outside the college. All of this was possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and teachers.

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As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

1. Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
2. Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
3. Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
4. Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
5. Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.
6. Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.
7. Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
8. Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
9. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

Punishment to those found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments.

1. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test / University Examination
2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
3. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
4. Suspension from the college
5. Cancellation of the admission
6. Withholding the results.

Anti Ragging Cell

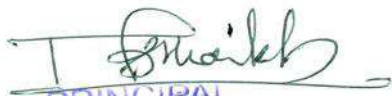

Anti ragging cell

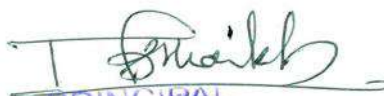

This Cell is functional with the Principal as the head, NAAC/IQAC Co-ordinator, one faculty member as Co-coordinator and three faculties as members. Prof. R.S.Nayak Co-ordinator discussed about the guidelines issued by MHRD regarding the steps to be taken to prevent incidents of ragging in the campus. An awareness class was given to the class prefects and asked them to propagate the message of anti ragging among students. Complaint boxes fixed in the campus were frequently checked, but no complaints about the ragging were found in the academic year. An orientation class was given to the fresher's so that they can report any kind of ragging to the teacher in charge without any hesitation. The rules to prevent ragging and its penalties were displayed in the notice board so that everyone will be aware about it.
