6.1.1: The institutional governance and leadership are in accordance with the vision and mission of the Institution and it is visible in various institutional practices such as NEP implementation, sustained institutional growth, decentralization, participation in the institutional governance and in their short term and long term Institutional Perspective Plan.

Our college is a Minority Higher Education Institution established in 1968 to cater educational requirements and aspirations of the people in and around Bhatkal irrespective of caste, creed or colour.



The core values of the college are aptly summed up in our Emblem and Motto. Our college emblem middle line reads “Allah Bestows Knowledge on Humanity”. The crescent and the star symbolize Muslim culture of our college. The Holy book below the crescent stands for what Allah ordained to his Prophet. The Light house and the coconut trees signify knowledge and location i.e., a coastal town (Bhatkal). The electric tower and the wheels stand for Technological Advancement and

Progress. The water reservoir at the right side of the emblem suggests that knowledge is like water in a reservoir irrigating the minds and quenching the thirst of the “Knowledge Seekers”.

Governance:

The Institution is managed by Anjuman Hami-e-Muslimeen (AHM). The organization structure of the Institution consists of President, 2 Vice President, General Secretary, Addl. Gen. Secretary, Finance Secretary, Works Board Secretary, College Board Secretary, Board Members, Principal (Ex-Officio Secretary) and IQAC. It is very apt here to remember with gratitude the educational Visionaries and Philanthropists of Anjuman Society from the year 1919. The Governing Body of the college which is the most important decision-making body which meets at least 7 times in a year as per the Management byelaw and is headed by the President of the AHM. Our esteemed Management always supportive to the Institution for the effective implementation of Vision, Mission statement of the college. After a thorough meeting with the staff and IQAC, the Principal forward the resolutions to the Management for its approval. Following is

the some of the list of implementations based on the Management Resolutions during the last five years –

- Incremental benefit due to the permanent staff from time to time .
- Promotional benefit to 2 non teaching staff from SDA to FDA and 1 from peon to Attender.
- Renovation of main building.
- Purchased 150 desks, 20 desktops, 05 LCD projectors.
- Organized zonal level 02 football, 01 Kabaddi and 01 shuttle badminton tournaments.
- Organized Fest “FUZIONA” (Management Fest).
- Recruited 14 Management full time teachers.

NEP Preparedness

Our's is the first University introduced NEP in 2021-22. Following is the detailed list of activities involved over the preparation of NEP. They are –

- Deputed almost all core subject faculty members to attend professional development programs on NEP.
- One of the faculty members served as a member, BoS for framing the course curriculum as per NEP structure.
- Procured 565 text books based on NEP.
- Installed Scilab and Maxima software for mathematics practical under NEP.
- Upgraded science laboratories with necessary science equipment.

Soon after getting the previous Institutional grade by NAAC, keeping in view for the sustained institutional growth, the IQAC along with senior faculty members prepared a comprehensive Plan of Actions for short and long term plan. For the successful implementations of the Plans, college has sought Management support and guidance. During the last five years, majority of them have been implemented successfully.

The college follows an effective democratic management system through participative decision making.
