Library Report 2019-20:

- Our college NSS Volunteers comes to the college every week and keeps the college premises clean and are doing the work like planting plants, watering the plants etc. They have cut and cleared the trees growing on both sides of the college road to enable easy traffic.
- Our NSS unit has 100 volunteers and the major programs undertaken in the college during the year 2019-20 are as follows:-

- Vanamahotsava Programme: Vanamahotsava was celebrated in collaboration with Anjuman PU College on 01st August 2019. It was celebrated by planting saplings in the presence of the President; Secretaries, Members of the Anjuman Management Board, teachers, staff and students of the college.
