This year a total of 298 books were added to our library with a cost Rs. 30,530/- Among which 297 books worth of Rs. 53,783/- were added to the U.G Section, and 01 book worth of Rs. 1095/- were added to the course of M.Com. in P.G Section.

Our library caters to the quality education by supporting curriculum and over all knowledge building of its user community. A state of the art e-Library is set up in the ground floor with 13 computer systems for the same. Besides we have our college digital library giving access to a no. of e-books, e-journals, e-newspapers, e-magazines, question papers, reference sources etc.

This year our library subscribed 22 International journals and 05 National journals, 51 Magazines & 13 News papers. During the year 2022-23 our college library has spent Rs. 74,000/- for periodicals subscription including 51 popular magazines and 13 Daily News papers of National and Regional in English, Kannada, Urdu and Hindi languages.
